I am very pleased to invite your team to our annual invitational soccer tournament to be held from the 17th to 19th of September 2010.

This tournament will be comprised of four separate competitions:

Men

- **Open Tournament**
- **Masters Tournament**

Ladies

- **Open Tournament**
- **Masters Tournament**

Each team is guaranteed three one hour games, each of which is one hour long. The first round follows a round-robin format. A random draw and club seeding process will be used to determine the groups. All games are played over three days, Friday Sept. 17th (depending on scheduling), Saturday Sept. 18th, and Sunday Sept. 19th. Depending on your final round robin placing, there will be semi-finals and finals. All semi-finals and finals are played on the Sunday. In the event that a group is too large, semi-finals may be dropped for an round in the round robin.

Please note that NO entry form will be accepted without complete payment. General Information

Prizes: Cash prizes awarded to top finishers. (TBA)

Eligibility: Men's Open Tournament: CUSA premier or lower division or equivalent teams (i.e. Commercial Division 1) teams may enter. Neither Major League Teams nor their players are eligible.

Ladies Open Tournament: CWSA premier or lower division may enter. Neither Major League Teams nor their players are eligible.

Master's Tournaments: Premier or lower division may enter. Neither Major League Teams nor their players are eligible.

All players must be registered to play with ASA or their provincial soccer association, ID's will be checked. It is not necessary to have season long rostered players; we encourage you to bring players from other teams to make up your numbers, but please remember that only 18 players may be dressed to play. You cannot crossover players between Open & Masters tournaments or between groups within your tournament division.

Entry Fee: **ENTRY DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 1st, 2010.** \$475.00 per team. Cheques are made payable to Cochrane Rangers Soccer Club and are to be mailed to the Club address. No refunds after September 1st, 2010.

Officials: A.S.A. equivalent or higher standard referees will officiate all games. We also provide linesman for all games.

Game Rules: We will endeavour to follow CUSA game rules (<http://www.cusa.ab.ca>) whenever appropriate. Substitutions are unlimited, but at the discretion of the referee. Only 18 players for each game can be dressed and on the game sheet. Absolutely no player/shirt changes are allowed during the game, unless advised to the referee prior to the game, and only because you are short of a jersey or two! Should this rule be broken, forfeiture of a game will result in a 2-0 loss.

Round Robin: Each game is one hour long. Three (3) points are awarded for a win, one (1) for a draw and zero (0) for a loss. An additional point is awarded for every goal to a maximum of three, whether you win or lose. A bonus point is awarded to the winning team for a shutout. The maximum number of points awarded per game is 7 (e.g. 5-0 win = 3 points for win, 3 points for goals and 1 point for shutout).

Semi-Finals: Each game is one hour long. No extra time, the winner will be decided via a penalty shoot-out.



Final: Each game is one hour long. If tied after 1 hour, 10 minutes of extra time will be played. Should the game be level after this, the winner will be decided via a penalty shoot-out.

Game Sheet: Please have your game sheet completed prior to kick-off and hand to the Referee. Referees will collect game sheets at the end of each game. Managers must fill out the referee evaluation

Discipline: This is an A.S.A. sanctioned tournament. Any discipline handed out by the officials will be dealt with by the A.S.A. The tournament committee will handle any local discipline. Playing an ineligible player will disqualify that player from the tournament and the team will forfeit the games that he/she played (automatic 2-0 loss).

Any player who physically abuses a game official and/or player will be automatically expelled from the tournament.

Please ask all players to keep their language 'family oriented' as children will be present all weekend. This is a fun tournament for all.

Red Cards: Automatic ban for the next game. A second red card disqualifies the player from the rest of the tournament.

Yellow Cards: Two yellow cards in a single game automatically ban the player from the next game. Two consecutive yellows in separate games will also ban the player from the following game. A third consecutive yellow will result in second single game ban.

Useful Info:

Check-In: Located at the "Tournament Office" which is at the Cochrane Rangers Fields, where the trophies are located. The team manager must collect the tournament package on Saturday morning prior to their first game, this will include the game sheets and other useful info.

Fields: A map will be provided indicating the fields that will be in use for this tournament.

Schedules: A provisional tournament schedule will be published a week prior to the tournament. This schedule is subject to change in the event that a team withdraws at the last minute, which rarely happens! Please refer to the schedule provided in your tournament package as this will be the finalised schedule.

Any teams that are scheduled to play Friday Sept. 17th will be notified in advance, every effort will be made to play all games on Saturday Sept. 18th & Sunday Sept. 19th.

Prizes: Cash prizes and trophies will be awarded after each final on Sunday afternoon unless other arrangements have been made. Prize amounts will be finalised after the entry closing date.
